MEMORIAL DAY EVENT

The public is invited to a "Reading" of the Veteran's Roll" on Monday, May 29, 2017 at 2 p.m. at Rienzi Cemetery.

The event will be held on the front steps of Rienzi's historic Memorial Home and will begin with a welcome from Chaplain Douglas Hedman.

Chaplain Hedman serves full-time with the Army National guard and works out of Madison.

Immediately following the welcome, volunteers will alternate reading the names of all known veterans buried at Rienzi Cemetery. Upon completion of the reading of the roll the Trier-Puddy Post 75 American Legion will fire a three volley of shots honoring the deceased veterans.

Water and treats will be available in the Memorial Home. It is very informal. We ask that attendees bring their lawn chairs and blankets and enjoy the afternoon at Rienzi. 


Grounds Superintendent's Report


